Re: Statement of Market Supply Charge - Capacity

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing a revision to the Statement of Market Supply Charge - Capacity ("MSC CAP") to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity as follows:

MSC CAP – Statement No. 57 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity

This Statement is to become effective on February 1, 2020.

The MSC CAP Statement is issued pursuant to General Rule 25.1 of P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity. It contains per-kWh charges applicable to energy-only rate classes and per-kW charges applicable to demand-billed classes. For customers billed under Rider M, the kW charges are applicable to the customer's installed capacity ("ICAP") tag. Other demand-billed customers pay for capacity based on their registered demand.

Pursuant to the <u>Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plan</u>, issued and effective January 16, 2020, in Case 19-E-0065, SC 1 Rate IV has been added to this statement.
