## RE: Case 19-G-0678 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission to Investigate Denials of Service Requests by National Grid USA, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY and KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consistent with Section 720 of the Commission's regulations (16 NYCRR Sec. 720), The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (the "Company") submits the following tariff leaf to become effective on July 1, 2020:

First Revised Leaf No. 64.1 To Schedule for Gas Service P.S.C. No. 12-GAS

Under the Settlement Agreement approved by the Commission by Order dated November 26, 2019 in the above-referenced proceeding, the Company agreed, among other things, to enhance its portfolio of energy efficiency and demand response programs. Accordingly, the Company developed an Efficiency Plan that includes a firm demand response program, under which participants will curtail load when requested by the Company. This program will help bridge the gap for the need for incremental natural gas supply to connect new customers pursuant to the Settlement Agreement.

The Company requests a waiver of the newspaper publication requirement under Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720.8.

In accordance with Section 720-2.3 of the Commission's Regulations, a proposed notice of this filing suitable for use under the State Administrative Procedure Act is also enclosed.
