Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) the following Statement of Purchase of Receivables (“POR”) Discount Percentage to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester.

The Statement is being issued to become effective on February 1, 2020.

Reason for Filing

The Company is filing the Statement of POR Discount Percentage to reflect the updated POR Credit & Collections target adopted in the January 16, 2020 Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plans in Case 19-E-0065. The POR Discount Percentage, as shown on the statement, includes the Uncollectible Bill Percentage, Risk Factor, Credit & Collections, and Incremental Cost components. The total POR Discount Percentage to be effective February 1, 2020, is 3.62%. In accordance with General Rule 19.3.6 of the Electric Tariff, the Company is filing its Statement of POR Discount Percentage no less than three days before the effective date.
