Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or "the Company") is filing today with the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission") Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge No. 14, effective March 1, 2020.

Explanation of Filing

Pursuant to the Joint Proposal¹ ("JP") adopted by the Commission in Case 19-G-0066², and the Delivery Revenue Surcharge provision under General Information IX.20 of the Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas, the Company will recover shortfalls and refund over-collections, including interest, that result from the extension of the suspension period in that case.

This filing establishes the Delivery Revenue Surcharge ("DRS"), by customer group, resulting from the extension of the suspension period in Case 19-G-0066. For those classes subject to the Revenue Decoupling Mechanism ("RDM") the surcharge (or credit), including interest, will be recovered from or returned to customers over the ten months beginning March 2020 and will be included in the RDM Adjustments effective March 1, 2020.

Summary

The Delivery Revenue Surcharge reflects delivery revenue net under-collections of \$14,799,688, consisting of \$14,756,229 related to classes subject to the RDM and \$43,459 related to SC 2 Rider H customers.
