Delivery Revenue Surcharge Reconciliation

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") hereby submits for filing Statement SDR-3 to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY ("Electric Tariff"). This Statement of Delivery Revenue Surcharge is issued February 26, 2020 to become effective March 1, 2020.

A Delivery Revenue Surcharge was established to collect shortfalls in non-competitive delivery service revenue that resulted from the extension of the Case 18-E-0067 suspension period, plus interest at the Commission's Other Customer Capital rate, over nine months commencing April 1, 2019. This filing implements the reconciliation of the Company's Delivery Revenue Surcharge mechanism for those nine months in accordance with General Information Section No. 33, Delivery Revenue Surcharge, of the Electric Tariff.

The cumulative net delivery revenue surcharge excess for the reconciliation period is \$25,475, including interest.

Customer group-specific adjustments have been determined to refund the net delivery revenue surcharge excess over the one-month period commencing March 1, 2020.

Attached as Appendix A to this filing are work papers showing the calculation of the adjustments set forth on Statement SDR-3.
