Dear Secretary Phillips:

The enclosed statements are transmitted electronically by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation (“NYSEG”) and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation (“RG&E”) for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission (“PSC” or “Commission”) of the State of New York, to become effective April 1, 2021.

In accordance with its tariff, NYSEG is initiating an interim reconciliation surcharge of \$0.064064/therm as a result of a projected under collection of gas costs. The interim reconciliation surcharge will remain in effect through August 2021.

In accordance with its tariff, RG&E is initiating an interim reconciliation surcharge of \$0.061477/therm as a result of a projected under collection of gas costs. The interim reconciliation surcharge will remain in effect through August 2021.
