Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with Section 720-2 *et al.* of the Commission's Regulations, 16 NYCRR § 720-2 *et al.*, The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY ("Company") hereby submits the following tariff leaves to become effective April 1, 2020:

Third Revised Leaf No. 125
First Revised Leaf No. 125.1
To Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 12-GAS. (the "Tariff")

The purpose of this filing is to correct a misplacement of required tariff language that should have been located in the General Information section of the Tariff applicable to all customers. On April 20, 2017, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Statewide Inspection Schedules and Procedural Requirements ("Order") in Case 15-G-0244 establishing certain inspection protocols and requirements for inside service line inspections. Utilities were directed to file tariff amendments in conformance with the Order to provide the following:

- 1) Termination of gas service due to an end-use customer's failure to provide access to allow for leakage surveys and corrosion inspections may occur; and
- 2) Customers that fail to provide access for inspections may be assessed a \$100 penalty. If the customer does not remit this penalty, normal termination procedures in Article 2 of the Public Service Law will apply. If the customer remits this penalty yet still denies access, a fifteen-day notice of termination will be provided to the customer.

In the Company's compliance filing, the amended language was inadvertently placed in Rule 44, which is the General Information Section that only applies to non-residential customers. Such placement does not align with the intention of the Order or placement of the tariff amendments in other utility tariffs, including Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation and KeySpan Gas East Corporation. This filing moves the required tariff language required by the Order to the General Information Section of the Tariff applicable to residential and non-residential customers.

The Company requests a waiver of the newspaper publication requirement under Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720.8.
