The purpose of this filing is to comply with Ordering Paragraph 2 which directed the Company to file proposed tariff revisions consistent with the Order. These revisions are:

- 1) Clarification that customers with fully automatic switchover equipment have the option of either Tier 1 or Tier 2;
- 2) Alternate Fuel Affidavit requirements and daily penalties;
- 3) Requirements for customers that violate the tariff twice in one winter season;
- 4) Definition of critical care customers.
