Dear Secretary Phillips:

In further compliance with Ordering Clause 1 of the Public Service Commission's *Order Implementing Hybrid Energy Storage System Tariff* ("Order") issued and effective December 13, 2018, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson or "the Company") hereby files the following revised tariff leaf to become effective December 16, 2019 on not less than 5 days' notice.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

7th Revised Leaf No. 272.1

The purpose of this filing is to clarify that Hybrid Facilities (*i.e.*, energy storage systems paired with qualifying electric generating equipment) that receive Value Stack compensation should not be required to take service under Service Classification No. 14 – Standby Service and may take service under their otherwise applicable service classification.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 2 of the aforementioned Order, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b), §92(2)(a), and NYCRR §720-8.1 regarding newspaper publication of these tariff amendments have been waived.
