## Re: Annual System Benefits Charge ("SBC") Filing

Dear Secretary Phillips,

Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") herein submits for filing its Statement of System Benefits Charge, Statement No. SBC – 10 to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY. This Statement is issued December 16, 2019, to become effective with service rendered on or after January 1, 2020.

This filing is in accordance with General Information Section 26 of the Company's Schedule for Electric Service requiring an annual SBC filing in accordance with the Commission's January 21, 2016 Order in Case 14-M-0094 et al. ("January 2016 Order").

The proposed SBC rate is based on an SBC collection target of \$21,616,096 as contained in the January 2016 Order for the period January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.<sup>1</sup> The determination of the proposed SBC rate also includes the reconciliation of SBC recoveries for the period January through December 2019. The amount under-collected for the reconciliation period is \$187,305. The resulting SBC rate is 0.582 cents per kWh.
