Re: Case 19-G-0191 – Matters Regarding Interruptible Service

Dear Secretary Phillips:

On March 14, 2019, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Company’s Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas. The tariff changes, which relate to Interruptible Service, were proposed to become effective on October 1, 2019.

On September 19, 2019, at the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service (“Staff”), the Company filed a postponement of the effective date of these tariff changes to November 1, 2019. Staff has requested a further postponement to December 1, 2019. Therefore, the Company is filing a postponement of the effective date of these changes to December 1, 2019. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 90 to P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to December 1, 2019.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of November 22, 2019. However, since the tariff leaves currently have an effective date of November 1, 2019, the Company respectfully requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement filed today into effect on short notice, i.e., November 1, 2019. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date.
