RE: Case 19-E-0421 - Village of Sherburne – Proposed modification to the customer crediting provision – including an annual reconciliation mechanism.

Dear Secretary Phillips,

The Commission's order approving tariff amendments with modification, issued November 14, 2019 asked that the Village file a modification, replacing "[t]he credit will be carried forward indefinitely or until consumed." with a provision for an annual reconciliation mechanism.

The Village of Sherburne hereby proposes the replacement of:

CUSTOMER CREDIT

The Customer will be credited monthly for energy (kWh) that is received by the Village of Sherburne from the Customer. This credit will be applied to the Customer's bill monthly. If more energy is received by the Village than used by the customer in any given month, the energy (kWh) credit will be applied to the following month. The credit will be carried forward indefinitely or until consumed.

CUSTOMER CREDIT

The Village of Sherburne is an equal opportunity provider and employer. The Customer will be credited monthly for energy (kWh) that is received by the Village of Sherburne from the Customer. This credit will be applied to the Customer's bill monthly. If a customer produces more energy than the customer consumes during an individual monthly billing cycle, a kWh credit will be carried forward until consumed or the end of February. If a customer produces more energy than consumed during the twelve-month period ending with the February meter reading, the Village will issue a credit to the customer's utility bill issued in March. The credit will be calculated by multiplying the kWh credit balance by the average of the Purchased Power Cost from the otherwise applicable Purchased Power Statements, as filed during the past twelve months. Upon payment of the credit, the kWh credit balance will be reset to zero.

The Village of Sherburne's fiscal reporting year is from the beginning of March through the end of the following February. The dates proposed above in the proposed Customer Credit paragraph will align with the Village's fiscal reporting year.

The modified tariff leaf 21 rev 1, effective December 1, 2019 is submitted with this letter.

As directed in Ordering Clause No. 1, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR §720-8.1 concerning newspaper publication of tariff amendments are waived for this filing.
