New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("the Companies") are transmitting for filing the following tariff leaves in further compliance with the New York State Public Service Commission's Order on Net Energy Metering Transition, Phase One of Value of Distributed Energy Resources, and Related Matters (the "Order"), issued and effective March 9, 2017. The tariff revisions are to become effective December 1, 2019.

P.S.C. No. 120 – Electric, Schedule for Electric Service Leaf No. 117.46.26, Revision 6

P.S.C. No. 19 – Electric, Schedule for Electric Service Leaf No. 160.39.21, Revision 7

Purpose of Filing

The Companies are submitting tariff revisions in further compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order.

More specifically, the Companies are filing revisions to allow mass market on-site projects and projects with a rated capacity of 750 kW or lower that are placed in service after January 1, 2020 to continue receive Phase One NEM compensation until a new compensation methodology is approved



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by the Commission¹. Once a new compensation methodology is approved, such projects will be transferred to the new compensation methodology.

Newspaper Publication

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 23 of the Order, newspaper publication in accordance with Public Service Law 66(12)(b) and 16 NYCRR 720-8.1 is waived.
