Dear Secretary Phillips:

In further compliance with Ordering Clause 1 of the Public Service Commission's Order on Net Energy Metering Transition, Phase One of Value of Distributed Energy Resources, and Related Matters issued and effective March 9, 2017, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson or "the Company") hereby files the following revised tariff leaves to become effective November 25, 2019 on not less than 5 days' notice.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

2nd Revised Leaf No. 163.9

3rd Revised Leaf No. 163.9.1

2nd Revised Leaf No. 163.9.2

4th Revised Leaf No. 163.9.5

The purpose of this filing is to extend the eligibility of Phase One Net Energy Metering to mass market and small wind projects that are placed in-service after January 1, 2020, and for large on-site projects that qualify on or after January 1, 2020, until such time that a new compensation methodology is established and becomes effective. At that time, the aforementioned projects would be transferred to the newly established compensation methodology.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 23 of the aforementioned Order, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b), §92(2)(a), and NYCRR §720-8.1 regarding newspaper publication of these tariff amendments have been waived.
