Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) a revised “Statement of Revenue Decoupling Mechanism Adjustment” (“RDM-PASNY”) to its Schedule for New York Power Authority (“NYPA” or “PASNY”) Delivery Service, P.S.C. No. 12 – Electricity, applicable to delivery by the Company of power and associated energy to Authority Public Customers under P.S.C. No. 12.¹

The statements submitted herewith are as follows:

RDM-PASNY Statement No. 22 to P.S.C. No. 12 – Electricity

The statement is issued on August 27, 2019, to become effective September 1, 2019.

Reason for Filing

Through this filing, the Company is revising the PASNY RDM Adjustments to reflect an additional net under-collection of revenues approximately of \$1.7 million, including interest, above the levels attributable to the NYPA classes in the RDM-PASNY Statement No. 21. The RDM adjustments for NYPA and KIAC have been determined to recover the additional net under collection for the September 2019 through January 2020 period.

As specified in our tariffs, the revised Statements are being filed with the Commission no less than three days before the start of the period for which the RDM Adjustments are to be in effect.

¹ PSC No. 12 is the Delivery Service Rate Schedule Implementing and Part of the Service Agreement between the Power Authority of the State of New York (PASNY) and the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the Company) dated March 10, 1989.
