## Re: Case 18-E-0732 Order Approving Addition of LED Street Lighting Options with Modifications

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 in the Public Service Commission's order issued and effective August 12, 2019 ("Order") in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files amended tariff leaves to its Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 – Electricity.

These tariff amendments are being filed August 27, 2019, to become effective September 1, 2019 to offer additional LED fixture options to Service Classification No. 5 and Service Classification No. 8 and reflect the following required modifications:

- Maintain newly added LED fixtures at the Rate Year 1 rates for Rate Years 2 and 3;
- Remove the requirement that LED fixtures be the default standard for the Company; and,
- Specify that customers will have the option to have failed non-LED fixtures replaced with LED fixtures at no cost to the customer.

Pursuant to Paragraph 3 of the Order and per the Commission approved Order 17-E-0459, the Company will file, in the next rate filing, a study to examine the rates and charges for all Company owned area and street lighting fixtures and compare them to all the underlying costs incurred to replace the fixture, maintain the fixture, and deliver energy to each of these fixtures.

Pursuant to Paragraph 4 of the Order, the requirements of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication for the amendments listed herein are waived.
