Dear Secretary Burgess:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) amendments to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas (the “Gas Tariff”), applicable to its customers in Manhattan, and the Bronx, the First and Third Wards of Queens and certain municipalities in the County of Westchester.<sup>1</sup>

The revised Tariff Leaves, which are identified below, are filed to become effective on September 1, 2019:

**Reasons for and Summary of Proposed Tariff Modifications**

On March 4, 2019, the Company filed proposed modifications to its Gas Tariff to provide for the recovery of certain costs associated with trucked and stored compressed natural gas (“CNG”) and liquefied natural gas (“LNG”) projects that are not currently covered by the

definitions of gas costs in the Gas Cost Factor (“GCF”) and Daily Delivery Service (“DDS”); and to modify the DDS security provision applicable to Gas Marketers participating in the Purchase of Receivables Program (the “March Filing”). The tariff changes were proposed to become effective July 1, 2019.

On May 31, 2019, at the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service (“Staff”), the Company postponed to September 1, 2019 the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed in the March Filing. Accordingly, the Company filed Supplement No. 86 to the Gas Tariff, to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to September 1, 2019.

Based upon further discussions with Staff, the Company is proposing changes to clarify the descriptions of Fixed Gas Costs in the GCF and to clarify the Tier 3 (Peaking Service) of the DDS to recover CNG and LNG project development costs.

### **Notice and Conclusion**

The Company has completed publication of the notice of the March Filing. Since the changes proposed today are only meant to further clarify the language proposed in the March Filing, the Company respectfully requests waiver from the Commission’s notice requirements with respect to the tariff changes filed today.
