Pursuant to Ordering Clause Number 1 of the *Order Addressing Petition and Directing Tariff Modifications* (issued June 17, 2019) (the “Order”) in the above referenced case, Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) hereby submits the following revised tariff leaves, which revise the delivery rates and service class deferral credits for the remainder of rate year 2 of the Company’s current rate plan, for customers served under Special Provision L of Service Classification No. 1 – Residential Optional Time of Use Delivery and Commodity Rate.

As a customer on the Residential Optional Time of Use Delivery and Commodity Rate (SC-1 VTOU rate), we are writing to inform you of a recently approved change in the delivery rates associated with your account. There is currently a three-year delivery rate plan approved by the New York Public Service Commission (NYPSC) for the period of April 1, 2018 through March 31, 2021.

Updated delivery rates for rate years 2 and 3 have been approved by the NYPSC. Below are some answers to questions that you might have.

What is the timing for the rate changes?

Updated rate year 2 delivery rates will take effect August 1, 2019 and go through March 31, 2020. Updated rate year 3 delivery rates will take effect April 1, 2020 and go through March 31, 2021.

What is changing?

There are two time-differentiated delivery rates in this service class.

- The **super peak/on-peak** delivery rate is applied year-round from 7 a.m. – 11 p.m. The delivery rate on your bill consists of the tariff delivery rate, the Earnings Mechanism Adjustment, and the Dynamic Load Management surcharges. The tariff delivery rate will change from \$0.06026 to \$0.07108 per kWh effective August 1, 2019. The tariff delivery rate will then change to \$0.07768 per kWh effective April 1, 2020.
- The **off-peak** delivery rate is applied year-round from 11 p.m. – 7 a.m. The delivery rate on your bill consists of the tariff delivery rate, the Earnings Mechanism Adjustment, and the Dynamic Load Management surcharges. The tariff delivery rate will change from \$0.00922 to \$0.01055 per kWh effective August 1, 2019. This tariff delivery rate will then change to \$0.01076 per kWh effective April 1, 2020.

Why didn't the Rate Year 2 changes take effect in the beginning of that rate year?

When National Grid initially submitted the three-year rate filing, we inadvertently did not include SC1 VTOU delivery rates for year 2 and 3. So, SC1 VTOU delivery rates for years 2 and 3 were approved after rate year two had already begun. We will not be retroactively applying the new rates to the beginning of rate year 2, which began April 1, 2019. The updated rate will take effect August 1, 2019.
