This filing is made in compliance with the Order, which directed the Company to file revisions as discussed in Ordering Clause 1 of the Order. This Ordering Clause requires the Company to continue existing standby rate exemptions for eligible distributed energy resources, including the limited exemption for CHP facilities greater than 1 MW and less than 15 MW until May 31, 2021.

Also, in compliance with Ordering Clause 1, the Company is filing on not less than one day’s notice to commence June 1, 2019. A further revised redline and clean version of the tariff leaves are attached.

In accordance with Ordering Clause 3 of this order, the requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8.1 concerning newspaper publication of the proposed tariff amendments have been waived.
