The purpose of this filing is to make further revisions to the original filing made on March 11, 2019 to reflect modifications required by the Commission's order in Case 18-M-0679 issued on April 22, 2019. The enclosed tariff leaves have been revised to include language in accordance with Ordering Clause 4 to clarify that a meter read fee will not be charged to customers where the company has the ability to read the customer's meter without sending personnel to the customer's premises.

Given the newly enacted statute went into effect immediately upon being signed by the Governor on August 24, 2018, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8 is requested for this filing.
