Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company" or "O&R") hereby submits for electronic filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission") 3rd Revised Leaf No. 156.9 and 5th Revised Leaf No. 157.9 to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY (the "Electric Tariff").

Reason for Filing

Ordering Clause 1 of the Commission's <u>Order Adopting Program Changes and Making Other Findings</u>, issued and effective April 23, 2018, in Case Nos. 14-E-0423 and 15-E-0191 (the "April Order"), directed the electric distribution utilities to file, by May 1, 2018, tariff amendments to implement changes to their distribution level demand response programs for the 2018 capability period required in the body of the April Order.

On April 30, 2018, the Company filed its compliance tariff revisions all of its existing distribution-level demand response programs: the Direct Load Control Program ("DLCP"), the Commercial System Relief Program ("CSRP"), and the Distribution Load Relief Program ("DLRP"). These programs are included in the Electric Tariff under Riders D, E and F, respectively.

Tariff Changes

After discussion with Commission Staff the Company has revised language from Section E of the Reservation Payment Option section of Riders E and F to clarify that if program participant's Performance Factor is calculated to be less than 0.25, the Performance Factor will be set to 0.00.

Conclusion and Notice

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 11 of the April Order, the requirement for newspaper publication is waived.
