Purpose of Filing

The Companies are submitting tariff revisions in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 1 of the Order.

Overview

The Order requires that NYSEG and RG&E to continue the existing statewide exemptions from standby rates and extends the in-service date deadline for eligible distributed energy resources until May 31, 2021. The Companies are also removing the Phase-In from the tariff; the Phase-In concluded in 2011 and the Order did not provide for extending the Phase-In.
