**Re: Case 18-M-0679 Order Approving Tariff Amendments with Modifications**

Dear Secretary Burgess:

In compliance with the Commission's Order Approving Tariff Amendments with Modifications in Case 18-M-0679, issued and effective April 22nd, 2019, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company"), hereby files the following tariff leaves to become effective May 1, 2019.

The purpose of this filing is to further clarify the changes to Public Service Law §39 and include the substance of the law's provision of a customer's right to an actual meter read. In addition, further clarification was made to address special meter readings fees to be assessed per customer and not per meter. Further revisions state there will be no charge to the customer when the company has the ability to read the customer's meter without sending personnel to the customer's premises.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 6 of the aforementioned Order, the requirements of section §66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law regarding newspaper publication have been waived.
