Enclosed are the following tariff leaves transmitted for filing by KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid (“Company”) in connection with the newly enacted New York Public Service Law Section 39, subdivision 4.

Third Revised Leaf No. 36
Fourteenth Revised Leaf No. 119.49

To Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. 1-GAS
Effective: 05/01/2019

The Company originally filed Leaf 36 to include language regarding a sales customer’s ability to request that their meters be read on a date other than the customer’s regularly scheduled meter read date at the associated fee. After an initial filing of the second revision to Leaf 36 on November 8, 2018, the Company is further revising this tariff leaf to clarify that subject to certain conditions, when a customer is disconnecting service and so requests, the Company is required to provide an actual meter read within 48 hours of the customer’s request. The Company is also filing Leaf 119.49 to include similar language for transportation customers.

Given the newly enacted statute went into effect immediately upon being signed by the Governor on August 24, 2018, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8 is requested for this filing.
