RE: Case 17-E-0238 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a/ National Grid for Electric Service.

Dear Secretary Burgess:

In accordance with the *Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plans* (issued and effective March 15, 2018) in Cases 17-E-0238 and 17-G-0239 (the “Order”), Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the “Company”) submits for filing the following street lighting tariff leaf as a further revision to the compliance filing on March 1, 2019.

Fourteenth Revised Leaf No. 40

To P.S.C. No. 214 Electricity

Effective: April 15, 2019

The revision to the tariff corrects a single price exception rate for the City of Buffalo (6. Company owned Foundation (concrete)) from \$20.20 to \$28.20. The impacted customer’s account has yet to bill with the new rate, so will not be affected.

As a revision to a temporary leaf, these further tariff changes are to be filed on not less than 3 days’ notice and will be effective on a continued temporary basis on April 15, 2019. Because of the limited customer impact created by the changes, the Company also requests waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of Public Service Law § 66-12 and 16 NYCRR § 720.8.

This filing is being made in accordance with Appendix 7-H (electronic filing system) to the Commission’s Codes, Rules and Regulations (16 NYCRR, Appendix 7-H). Attachment 1 included with this filing contains redlined leaves showing this change.
