RE: Actual Meter Reading Law Change

Dear Secretary Burgess:

Enclosed is the following tariff leaf transmitted for filing by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("Company") in connection with the newly enacted New York Public Service Law Section 39, subdivision 4.

Leaf No. 214 Revision No. 2
To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity
Effective: May 1, 2019

The Company's electricity tariff originally included language regarding a customer's ability to request that their meters be read on a date other than the customer's regularly scheduled meter read date at the associated fee, but with a 15 calendar day notice requirement. After an initial filing of the first revision to Leaf 14 on November 15, 2018, the Company is further revising this tariff leaf to include the customer's right to a reading of the meter within 48 hours of their request to discontinue service. Given the newly enacted statute went into effect immediately upon being signed by the Governor on August 24, 2018, waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL §66-12 and 16NYCRR 720.8 is requested for this filing. A further revised redline and clean version of the tariff leaf is attached.
