Dear Secretary Phillips:

In compliance with the New York State Public Service Commission's <u>Order Adopting Revised Gas</u> <u>Supply Procedures and Requirements and Directing Tariff Filings</u>, issued and effective October 18, 2012, New York State Electric & Gas Corporation ("NYSEG" or "Company") hereby files the following Weighted Average Cost of Capacity Statement ("WACC Statement") to be effective February 1, 2021.

WACC Statement No. 11 to PSC No. 88 Gas

In accordance with NYSEG's tariff, the Company shall reset the capacity release rate if in any month, the actual Weighted Average Cost of Capacity ("WACOC") differs from the calculated WACOC by more than 5%.

The release prices set forth in the WACC Statement are reset because the 5% threshold change has been met. The change is primarily due to a rate increase that was filed by Columbia Gas Transmission, LLC ("Columbia Gas") with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission on July 31, 2020¹. NYSEG notified Energy Services Companies ("ESCOs") of the Columbia Gas rate increase through the Gas Transportation tracking system on September 17, 2020, and at a meeting with ESCOs on October 22, 2020. The WACOC also includes three (3) new NYSEG capacity contracts, one (1) contract that commenced on September 1, 2020 and two (2) contracts that commenced on November 1, 2020.
