Re: Miscellaneous Charge Factor II

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with General Information, Section 29 of P.S.C. No. 15 - Electricity, the Statement of Miscellaneous Charge, including the Miscellaneous Factor II and Electric Vehicle Make-Ready ("EVMR") Surcharges, listed below is filed to become effective February 2, 2021.

P.S.C. No. 15 – Electricity

Statement of Miscellaneous Charge - MISC 246

The purpose of the Miscellaneous Factor II surcharge is to recover the costs of the Company's non-wires alternative infrastructure project approved for recovery pursuant to the July 15, 2016 Order in Case 14-E-0318 from all delivery customers served under this schedule.

Pursuant to Order in Case 18-E-0138 dated July 16, 2020, the Company will implement a new Electric Vehicle Make-Ready ("EVMR") Program factor designed to recover the following costs as addressed by the Commission in Case 18-E-0138:

- (a) Utility-Owned Make-Ready Work
- (b) Customer-Owned Make-Ready Work
- (c) Other Programs
- (d) Make-Ready Implementation Costs

The EVMR factor will be effective the first billing batch in February 2021 to refund or recover the costs of this program in a new Electric Vehicle Make-Ready Surcharge ("EVS") statement, updated and filed annually with rates rolling up into the existing Miscellaneous Charges for billing purposes. The Statement of Miscellaneous Charge filed herein incorporates the factors found on the EVS Statement being filed contemporaneously.
