RE: Case 20-E-0444, Energy Storage Deployment Program

Dear Secretary Phillips:

On September 4, 2020, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission proposing changes to the Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, and the Schedule for PASNY Delivery Service, P.S.C. No. 12 – Electricity, regarding the recovery of the energy storage deployment program. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective on January 1, 2021.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is postponing to February 1, 2021, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on September 4, 2020. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 69 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity, and Supplement No. 31 to P.S.C. No. 12 – Electricity, to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to February 1, 2021.

The Supplement is issued on 30 days’ notice and has an effective date of January 1, 2021. The Company respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements for the effective date change.
