Dear Secretary Phillips:

On August 31, 2020, Orange and Rockland Utilities, Inc. (the "Company") made a tariff filing with the Public Service Commission (the "Commission"), proposing changes to its Schedule for Electric Service, P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY, pursuant to the Commission's *Notice of Tariff Filings due to Amendment of the Public Authorities Law*, in Case 20-E-0376 issued July 29, 2020. The tariff changes were proposed to become effective January 1, 2021.

At the request of the Staff of the Department of Public Service, the Company is postponing to February 1, 2021, the effective date of the tariff changes that were filed on August 31, 2020. Accordingly, the Company hereby submits Supplement No. 44 to P.S.C. No. 3 – ELECTRICITY to postpone the effective date of the tariff changes to February 1, 2021.

This Supplement is issued on 30 days' notice and has an effective date of January 15, 2021. However, since the tariff leaves currently have an effective date of January 1, 2021, the Company requests that it be authorized to put the Supplement filed today into effect on short notice, <u>i.e.</u>, January 1, 2021. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements for the effective date change.
