**Re: Case 20-G-0150 Order Temporarily Amending Certain Gas Tariff Provisions**

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby submits the tariff amendments listed below on November 25, 2020 to become effective December 1, 2020.

Pursuant to Public Service Commission Order, issued and effective March 31, 2020 Order in Case 20-G-0150, amendments to the above tariff leaves were originally filed on March 31, 2020 to become effective on April 1, 2020 on an emergency basis in response to the Governor's March 7, 2020 Executive Order No. 202. Amendments were made waiving daily imbalance penalties for Retail Suppliers delivering gas supply outside the prescribed deadband, and adjusting the Index pricing applied to Retail Suppliers' over- and under-deliveries such that the average of the existing Index prices be used for both over- and under-deliveries.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 3 of the aforementioned Order, the Company hereby files the above tariff amendments to remove the temporary provisions on five days' notice, to become effective on December 1, 2020 as the Governor's Executive Order 202.8 requiring non-essential businesses to reduce their in-person workforce has been lifted.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 5 of the aforementioned Order, the Company requests a waiver of the requirements of 66(12) (b) of the Public Service Law as to newspaper publication for the amendments listed herein.
