Reason for Filing

In accordance with the Commission’s Order Granting Rehearing in Part and Denying Rehearing in Part, issued and effective August 14, 2020, in the above-referenced cases, (the “Order”), the Company is filing a further tariff revision to expand the definition of Critical Care Customer to include assisted living facilities, rehabilitation centers, and homeless shelters.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by the Order in Ordering Clause 1, the Company is filing its tariff revision on not less than five days’ notice to become effective on October 1, 2020. Pursuant to Ordering

Clause 2, the Commission has waived the requirements for newspaper publication.
