RE: Case 20-M-0231, Statement of Emergency Summer Cooling Credit

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the "Company") is filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the "Commission") the following updated Statement of Emergency Summer Cooling Credit ("ESCC") to the Company's Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the "Electric Tariff").

ESCC Statement No. 4 to PSC No. 10 - Electricity Effective September 15, 2020

Reason for Filing

Pursuant to SC 1 Special Provision I of the Electric Tariff, the Company is issuing an updated Statement of ESCC. The updated Statement of ESCC reflects the ESCC applicable to Customers active in the Company's Low Income Program as of September 10, 2020, with bills scheduled to be issued from September 15, 2020 through October 14, 2020. Pursuant to the Commission's Order Approving Temporary Emergency Financial Relief for Electric Low-Income Bill Discount Program Customers, issued and effective June 11, 2020, in Case No. 20-M-0231 (the "Order"), the ESCC is to be determined based on the budget for each period specified in the Order divided by the number of active customers in the Low Income Program for each period; provided that the ESCC shall not exceed \$40 (inclusive of Gross Receipts Tax ("GRT") and sales tax). The number of active customers in the Low Income Program as of September 10, 2020 was 456,547. This results in the ESCC credit to exceed \$40 (inclusive of GRT and sales tax). Therefore, the ESCC effective September 15, 2020 will be \$36.62 per month, which is the ESCC credit of \$40 exclusive of estimated GRT and sales tax. Low Income Customers will receive the applicable GRT and sales tax, as a further credit, on this credit amount.

As specified in the Electric Tariff, the updated Statement of ESCC is being filed with the Commission on not less than one business day's notice prior to the effective date.
