Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with Matter No. 14-00702, enclosed for filing is Frontier Telephone of Rochester, Inc. - Telephone tariff filing to detariff non-basic retail telecommunications services. This filing will be superseding the existing tariff (P.S.C. No. 2) and moving basic retail telecommunications services to a new tariff (P.S.C. No. 6). Non-basic services will be included in a new Retail Catalog with a proposed effective date of November 16, 2020.
