## Re: Case 19-M-0463- Order Regarding Consolidated Billing for Community Distributed Generation

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In compliance with Ordering Clause 8 of the Public Service Commission's order issued and effective December 12, 2019 ("Order") in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files the following revised tariff leaves to become effective October 1, 2020 on not less than 30 days' notice.

The purpose of these tariff amendments is to adopt the implementation of the Net Crediting model of consolidated billing as an option for all Value Stack Community Distributed Generation projects, both existing and new. These amendments implement the Net Crediting Program as also detailed in Central Hudson's Net Crediting Manual and the Joint Utilities Net Crediting Agreement both filed on August 31, 2020 in this proceeding. The Company will allow enrollment beginning January 1, 2021 (for new projects) and January 30, 2021 (for existing projects) for a program effective date of March 1, 2021.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 12 of the aforementioned Order, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b), §92(2)(a), and NYCRR §720-8.1 regarding newspaper publication of these tariff amendments have been waived.
