Attached for filing electronically with the New York State Public Service Commission (“Commission”) is Supplement No. 105 to Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 12-GAS issued by The Brooklyn Union Gas Company d/b/a National Grid NY (the “Company”) to become effective September 1, 2020.
