Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (the “Company”) is filing with the New York State Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) the following updated Statement of Emergency Summer Cooling Credit (“ESCC”) to the Company’s Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Electric Tariff”).

ESCC Statement No. 2 to PSC No. 10 - Electricity
Effective July 16, 2020

Reason for Filing

Pursuant to SC 1 Special Provision I of the Electric Tariff, the Company is issuing an updated Statement of ESCC. The updated Statement of ESCC reflects the ESCC applicable to Customers active in the Company’s Low Income Program as of July 10, 2020, with bills scheduled to be issued from July 16, 2020 through August 13, 2020. The ESCC was determined based on the budget for the second period specified in the Commission’s Order Approving Temporary Emergency Financial Relief for Electric Low-Income Bill Discount Program Customers, issued and effective June 11, 2020, in Case No. 20-M-0231, divided by the number of active customers in the Low Income Program as of July 10, 2020. The number of active customers in the Low Income Program as of July 10, 2020 was 460,509. This results in the ESCC effective July 16, 2020 to be \$35.79 per month. Low Income Customers will receive the applicable GRT and sales tax, as a further credit, on this credit amount.

As specified in the Electric Tariff, the updated Statement of ESCC is being filed with the Commission on not less than one business day's notice prior to the effective date.
