RE: Case 17-G-0239 – Proceeding on Motion of the Commission as to the Rates, Charges, Rules and Regulations of Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a/ National Grid for Gas Service – Rate Year 3 Compliance Filing Effective August 1, 2020

Dear Secretary Phillips:

In accordance with the *Order Adopting Terms of Joint Proposal and Establishing Electric and Gas Rate Plans* (issued and effective March 15, 2018) in Cases 17-E-0238 and 17-G-0239 (the “Order”), Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation d/b/a National Grid (the Company”) submits for filing the gas tariff leaves listed on Attachment 1 for P.S.C. No. 219 for Gas Service – Gas.

The Company filed tariff changes on February 28, 2020 in compliance with Ordering Clause No. 6 of the Order, which directed the Company to file further tariff changes as are necessary to effectuate the rate year three rates as approved and provided for in the Order. However, on March 25, 2020, the Commission issued an *Order on Postponing Approved Electric and Gas Delivery Rate Increases and Temporarily Waiving Certain Tariff Fees* (“Postponement Order”) directing the Company to file a supplemental postponement of the February 28, 2020 tariff leaves until July 1, 2020.

In addition, on May 29, 2020, the Commission issued a subsequent *Order Further Postponing Approved Electric and Gas Delivery Rate Increases and Updated Reduction to the Low Income Discount Credits* (“Further Postponement Order”) directing the Company to file a second supplemental postponement until August 1, 2020 and on July 1, 2020 the Company filed rate year three rates in compliance with that Further Postponement Order. After consulting with Department of Public Service Staff (“Staff”), the Company is filing further revisions to the tariff leaves included in the July 1, 2020 filing with updated information to be effective on a temporary basis on August 1, 2020. A redlined version of the tariff leaves is attached in Attachment 2.

In accordance with Ordering Clause No. 7 of the Further Postponement Order the requirements of Public Service Law §66 (12) (b) and 16 New York Codes, Regulations and Rules §720-8.1 as to newspaper publication of the directed modifications have been waived.
