Re: Statement of Market Supply Charge - Capacity

Dear Secretary Phillips:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Con Edison" or the "Company") is filing a revision to the Statement of Market Supply Charge - Capacity ("MSC CAP") to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity as follows:

MSC CAP – Statement No. 60 to P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity

This Statement is to become effective on May 1, 2020.

The MSC CAP Statement is issued pursuant to General Rule 25.1 of P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity. It contains per-kWh charges applicable to energy-only rate classes and per-kW charges applicable to demand-billed classes. For customers billed under Rider M, the kW charges are applicable to the customer's installed capacity ("ICAP") tag. Other demand-billed customers pay for capacity based on their registered demand.

The rates included on this statement reflect increases in the price of capacity due to wholesale market forces and changes in capacity cost allocation. Given the extraordinary circumstances of the COVID-19 pandemic and its economic impacts, the Company is exploring options to mitigate the impacts of these increases on customers' summer 2020 bills.
