Pursuant to the Commission's April 23, 2020 Order Suspending Minor Rate Filing¹ ("Order") in the above referenced case, the Village of Freeport, Freeport Electric ("Village" or "Freeport") attached for filing is a consecutively numbered Supplement No. 7, suspending the proposed amendments through August 28, 2020.

On August 7, 2019, the Village filed with the Commission draft revised tariff leaves for PSC No. 9, Electricity containing revisions to rates and charges as contained in the following:

Leaf No. 57, Revision 4 Leaf No. 58, Revision 5 Leaf No. 59, Revision 3 Leaf No. 60, Revision 5 Leaf No. 62, Revision 3 Leaf No. 64, Revision 3

The tariff amendments were filed with an effective date of January 1, 2020. Newspaper

publication regarding this filing was subsequently made in accordance with the Commission's regulations in the local newspaper. In consultations with Staff and to allow for a thorough review of the Village's application, the Village filed a series supplements to postpone the effective date to May 1, 2020. Due to the Village's concern regarding the negative impacts of the Coronavirus pandemic on Village residents, the Village subsequently filed a deferral of the effective date of the rate increase through September 30, 2020. On April 23, 2020, the Commission issued an Order suspending the proposed revisions through August 28, 2020 and directed the Village to file a supplement announcing the further suspension of the amendments.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 3 of the Commission's Order, attached for filing with the Commission is Supplement No. 7 to P.S.C. No. 9 – Electricity issued by the Village of Freeport and effective on one day's notice. The Village respectfully requests a waiver of newspaper publication of this Supplement.
