Enclosed herewith are the following materials, issued and transmitted for filing on behalf of the City of Jamestown, Board of Public Utilities ("BPU"), in accordance with the requirements of the Public Service Commission ("Commission") in the above referenced case.

1. Revised tariff leaf for P.S.C. No . 7 Electricity, containing provisions for adding language related to the provision of billing information for residential rental premises:

First Revised Leaf No. 31

The Public Service Law ("PSL") was amended, effective April 18, 2020, to include provisions to allow a prospective tenant or lessee to receive, at no cost, the total electricity charges incurred at the prospective residential rental premises for the life of the premises, or the preceding two-year period, whichever is shorter, within ten days of providing a written request. The Commission issued a notice on January 22, 2020 for gas and electric utilities to review their tariffs to ensure compliance with amended PSL § 66-p.¹ Accordingly, the BPU is proposing to amend its tariff to include provisions governing the terms of its residential service to provide a landlord or lessor of a residential premise billing information within ten days of receipt, if requested in writing, for the purposes of sharing it with a prospective tenant. Historically we have provided this information as a normal course of business operations.

The BPU respectfully requests a waiver of the newspaper publication requirements of PSL § 66-p as the proposed tariff changes are clarifying in nature and the provisions of the amended statute are already in effect.

Accordingly, we respectfully request that the Commission approve the revised tariff change and that such change is made effective October 1, 2020.
