Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 1 in the Public Service Commission's order issued and effective May 14, 2020 ("Order") in the above captioned proceeding, Central Hudson Gas & Electric Corporation ("Central Hudson" or "the Company") hereby files amended tariff leaves to its Schedule for Electric Service, PSC No. 15 – Electricity.

These tariff amendments are being filed May 29, 2020, to become effective June 1, 2020 to comply with the changes to the Dynamic Load Management ("DLM") program required in the body of the Order including:

During the summer Capability Period of 2020 only:

- Customers that currently have installed interval metering, must submit a completed application on or before June 1, 2020 for a commencement date of July 1, 2020;
- Changes to enrolled participants kW will be accepted for July 1 enrollment;
- Participants with interval metering, but without metering communications, enrollment will be allowed, however, incentive payments will be withheld until communication services are established and the necessary data downloaded; and
- The program currently does not have a minimum performance requirement, and will not adopt a minimum performance requirement for 2020.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph 4 of the Order, the requirements of Public Service Law §66(12)(b) regarding newspaper publication of these tariff amendments has been waived.
