The attached statement, issued by Niagara Mohawk, d/b/a/ National Grid ("Company"), is being transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

Statement of Supply Service Charges No. 41

To P.S.C. No. 220 Electricity

Effective: April 30, 2015

The above statement is being filed in accordance with Rule No. 46.4-Supply Service Charges in PSC No. 220 Electricity. Attachment 1 of this filing displays the derivation of these charges. Also, included in this statement is the residential agricultural discount rate in accordance with Rule No. 46.2.6.7 in PSC No. 220 Electricity.

Please note that the reconciliation of March revenue and expenses created a large Electricity Supply Reconciliation Mechanism ("ESRM") credit owed to Mass Market customers (SC-1 and SC-2ND) in May. Therefore, in accordance with Rule 46.3.4 of the tariff, the Company implemented the Supply Reconciliation Balance ("SRB") mechanism for the Mass Market customers which is included in the May ESRM rate shown on the P.S.C No. 220 statement. By delaying a portion of the ESRM reconciliation, the Company can mitigate the large month to month bill variances for customers that are caused by reconciliations from prior months.

This Supply Service Charge Statement is to be filed with the Commission on not less than three (3) business days notice before the effective date. Supply Service Statement No.41 is effective April 30, 2015 for batch billed customers, and May 1, 2015 for calendar month billed customers.
