RG&E has incorporated a surcharge for the reconciliation of purchased gas costs and gas cost recoveries for the 12 months ended August 31, 2014. The surcharge will remain in effect for the 12-month period beginning January 1, 2015. The supporting data and workpapers underlying the gas supply costs are filed monthly with the GSC statement.

In compliance with PSC Order in Case 14-G-0379, issued and effective December 11, 2014, the Company is changing the denominator used in the calculation of the Gas Supply Charge (GSC) from historical normalized sales to forecasted normalized sales. Also this month, the Company will be providing Appendix 7-H workpapers with the GSC filing (under trade secret protection).

These rates will continue in effect until there are changes in the cost of gas that require modifications.
