Re: Case 13-M-0551 Tariff filings by New York State Electric & Gas Corporation and Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation to Modify Their Electric and Gas Tariff Schedules to Make the Tariff Language Consistent Where Both Companies' Processes are the Same

The enclosed Supplements, issued by Rochester Gas and Electric Corporation ("RG&E") and New York State Electric and Gas Corporation ("NYSEG") (together the "Companies"), are transmitted for filing in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Public Service Commission.

Supplement No. 21 to PSC No. 16 – Gas Supplement No. 40 to PSC No. 19 – Electricity Supplement No. 23 to PSC No. 87 – Gas Supplement No. 34 to PSC No. 88 – Gas Supplement No. 16 to PSC No. 90 – Gas Supplement No. 10 to PSC No. 119 - Electricity Supplement No. 30 to PSC No. 120 – Electricity

Effective: April 5, 2014.

Based on discussions with Department of Public Service Staff, these postponement supplements are being filed to permit additional review of the filing. These supplements propose to further postpone the effective date of the filed tariff leaves until June 1, 2014. The Companies request that these supplements become effective on short notice and will take effect on April 1, 2014.

The Companies request that the requirement of Section 66(12)(b) of the Public Service Law and 16 NYCRR Section 720-8.1 as to newspaper publication be waived as these revisions do not affect any internal procedures or processes, and will not directly impact the Companies' customers.
