Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (“Con Edison” or the “Company”) is filing with the Public Service Commission (the “Commission”) an amendment to the Company’s Schedule for Electricity Service, P.S.C. No. 10 – Electricity (the “Tariff”), applicable to its customers in the City of New York and the County of Westchester. The Tariff leaf, which is identified below, has an effective date of February 20, 2014.

Reason for Filing

The Commission in its Order Accepting IPEC Reliability Contingency Plans, Establishing Cost Allocation and Recovery, and Denying Requests for Rehearing (the “Order”), issued and effective November 4, 2013, directed that the Company file tariff amendments to effectuate recovery through the Monthly Adjustment Clause (“MAC”) of the 125 MW Energy Efficiency/Demand Reduction/Combined Heat and Power Program costs that were allocated to the Company in the Order, amortized over ten years.

The Company is adding MAC component 37 for recovery of the 125 MW Energy Efficiency/Demand Reduction/Combined Heat and Power Program costs, pursuant to the Commission’s Order.

¹ Revision No. 1 is pending in Case 13-E-0030, the Company’s electric rate case.

Conclusion and Notice

As directed by Ordering Clause 5 of the Order, the tariff amendment is being filed, on not less than 30 days' notice, to become effective on February 20, 2014 (i.e., on or before March 1, 2014), on a temporary basis.

Pursuant to Ordering Clause 8, the Commission has waived newspaper publication of the tariff change. As directed by Ordering Clause 5, copies of this filing are being sent electronically to the active party list in Case 12-E-0503.
