Re: Case 13-G-0186, Temperature Control Elimination

Dear Secretary Burgess:

By the letter dated April 25, 2013, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("the Company") filed with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") tariff amendments to its Schedule for Gas Service, P.S.C. No. 9 – Gas ("the Tariff"), to become effective August 1, 2013. The amendments to the Gas Tariff include elimination of the Temperature Control Option as a means of interruptions for SC 9 transportation and SC 12 sales interruptible gas service.

The effective date of the leaves was postponed to October 1, 2013, at the request of Department of Public Service Staff, to allow time for further review of the proposed changes. The effective date was further postponed to April 1, 2014, to allow the Company sufficient time to conduct outreach and education to those customers who would be affected by the changes.

The Company is now requesting a further postponement of the effective date to June 1, 2014, pending the outcome of the February 20, 2014 Commission Session in regard to the Company's Joint Proposal in Case 13-G-0031 (the Company's gas rate case). The Joint Proposal proposes that the Company amend this tariff filing to allow existing temperature control customers to continue to utilize the temperature control option.

The Company accordingly files Supplement No. 56 to postpone the effective date of the above-referenced tariff amendments to June 1, 2014. Supplement No. 56 is issued February 18, 2014, with an effective date of March 20, 2014. The Company also respectfully requests waiver of notice requirements of the proposed change in the effective date since it does not affect the content of the original filing.
