The above leaves are being submitted in compliance with the above order which directed the Company to file tariff amendments consistent with the discussion in the body of this order on not less than thirty day’s notice, to become effective on January 1, 2014.

Also, Rule 34.6.4.1, included with this filing, has been revised to clarify that when a customer accepts a Recharge New York (“RNY”) allocation or whenever the Company receives notification from NYPA that the customer’s RNY allocation is changing or whenever the customer qualifies for the Empire Zone Rider (“EZR”) or Excelsior Jobs Program (“EJP”), the customer complies with the billing methodologies as stated in this rule.
