On March 9, 2012, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) approved a settlement between Constellation and FERC which resulted in Constellation paying a civil penalty and \$110 million in disgorged profits. On September 20, 2013 the Commission issued the above order directing the listed utilities to implement their plans for the implementation of customer refunds as described in this order and file tariff amendments to implement the refund. The Company complied with this directive and filed Rule No. 31-Market Settlement on September 20, 2013. The Company was also approved to distribute the refund to its customers in one month during the November 2013 billing cycle.

The attached Statement sets forth the credit that will be applied to batch billed customer's usage effective October 29, 2013 through November 26, 2013 and calendar month customer's usage October 1, 2013 through October 31, 2013.
