Attached for filing electronically are the following tariff leaves issued by KeySpan Gas East Corporation d/b/a National Grid ("KEDLI" or the "Company") to become effective on a December 6, 2013:

The purpose of this filing is to amend the Company's tariff to reflect forthcoming changes to its current Balanced Billing Plan resulting from a planned billing system conversion later this year. The Company currently utilizes the Customer Accounting System ("CAS") for its customer billing. The Company is in the process of converting from CAS to the Customer Service System ("CSS") (currently anticipated to occur December 2013). As a result of this billing system conversion, there will be some changes to the administration of the Company's Balanced Billing Plan and, therefore, KEDLI is modifying its tariff to reflect the following changes:

- KEDLI's balance billing plan will be called the "Budget Billing Plan." The tariff will be amended throughout to reflect this name change.
- Quarterly reviews of the budget bill accounts will be made automatically and any necessary adjustments to mitigate large imbalances at the end of the budget plan will be made.
- The customer will have the option of settling the budget bill plan at the end of the twelve month cycle or rolling-over the imbalance to the next budget bill plan cycle.

Additionally, unrelated to the CSS conversion, the Company is updating the list of Incorporated Villages served to include the Village of Sagaponock.

In accordance with Section 720-2.3 of the Commission's Regulations, a proposed notice of this filing suitable for use under the State Administrative Procedure Act is also enclosed.
